Klaben manager advised the owner, John is a customer here. At the time, John didn't report this incident. On 7/17 around noon, John returned to Klaben and spoke with the manager, Jeff Ashley. They reached an agreement and worked it out. John admitted to hitting the truck. He was looking to the right, distracted by another oncoming vehicle, and it was in his blind spot.</i>
